

2. The Words of Your Mouth Proverbs 18:21

A. #2 Our Words – the words we speak will bless us or hurt us

1. **(Genesis 1:2-4; v11-12; v24-25)**

**Genesis 1:2** The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. **v3** Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. **v4** And God saw the light, that it was good NKJV

- a. **v2** God saw darkness, and the waters, but He spoke light; speak what you want, not what you see; when God saw something that did not agree with His will, He spoke what He desired
- b. the water was there, the darkness was there, the Holy Spirit was there, nothing happened until words were spoken

**Genesis 1:11** Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; and it was so. **v12**.....And God saw that it was good. NKJV

**Genesis 1:24** Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind"; and it was so. **v25**.....And God saw that it was good. NKJV

- c. God spoke what He wanted, 'and it was so' what He spoke happened and what He spoke was good, 'And God saw that it was good;' He did not speak what He did not want
- d. This is a spiritual law; we are spirit beings and our words have creative power just like the Lord's words
- e. A huge roadblock to faith and healing is speaking negative words that stop the blessings of God from manifesting in your life

2. **(Proverbs 18:21)** our mouth can speak death and life; you must see this

**Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit. NKJV

- a. **James 3:8-10** our mouth can bless and curse; the choice is ours, no one else's
  - 'no man can tame the tongue' no natural man can, a BA, BHS man can
  - Your mouth is capable of incredible blessings or curses for you or others

**Joshua 1:8** This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

**John 12:50** .....therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak."

**Psalms 141:3** Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; Keep watch over the door of my lips.

3. **Numbers 13:2** God told them before they went into the promised land that He gave them the land; **(Joshua 2:8-11)** Rahab told the Jewish spies the people of Jericho were terrified of the Jews when they heard what the Lord did for them in Egypt
  - a. **v25-33** there were different opinions from the spies – 10 said they could not take the land and 2 said they could; do you see God in your circumstances or your circumstances?
  - b. **Numbers 14:14:26-30 v27** doubt is evil to the Lord when He said you can do or have something
    - **v28 & v30** the Lord said they were all going to have what they said
  - c. **v36-38**; 2 spies said they could take the land and 10 said they could not; both were right
4. **(John 8:44)** the devil is a liar – he is good at it – that is why you must renew your mind and build your faith on the Word

**John 8:44** You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

- a. **Matthew 6:25-31** worry, worry, speak your fears
  - The Lord is well aware of your needs, you can always trust Him
  -

**James 1:6** But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. **v7** For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; **v8** he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

5. **(Mark 11:23)** you will have whatever you say; Jesus did not say that you will have only good; you decide what you believe and say

**Mark 11:23** For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. NKJV

6. **(Hebrews 11:3)** Jesus created everything with His words – so do we

**Hebrews 11:3** By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. NKJV

- a. **Hebrews 1:3** Jesus also maintains everything with His words – so do we
